CMP Service Rifle Program for 2010



Again this year, SCFC will have a CMP Service Rifle Program. It will begin with a Clinic on May 1. Matches will be held the second Saturday of each month from May through September.

The clinic on May 1 is provided for new and prior participants in preparation for participation in matches. It will include rules of the game, scoring and coaching of shooting positions.

A military rifle and 50 rounds of ammunition are required.

Participants in a match will be qualified to purchase firearms from the CMP.
