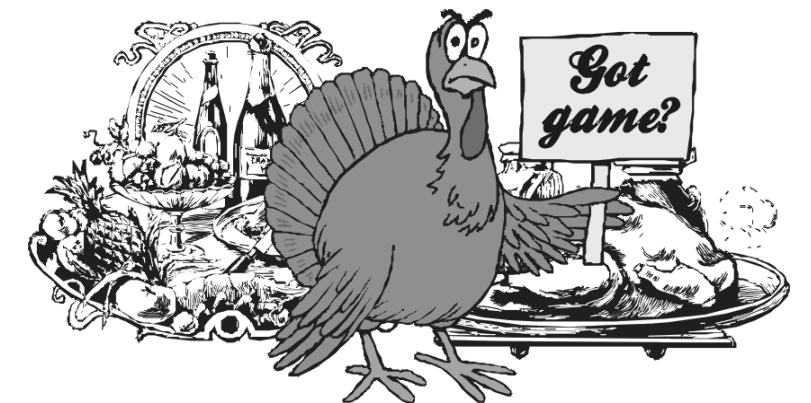
The website will be the primary means of notifying members about club events and anything that affects shooting range availability.

This summer, on the outdoor range, there have been numerous reports of someone moving forward of the firing line to check their targets while others are still shooting. Also, at the 25 yard line, some have started shooting while others are checking targets at the 100 or 200 yard backstops. These are serious safety violations

**All guns on the line are to be unloaded and benched when anyone is forward of the firing line.**
